

Lesson 6: Grammar: Objects & Object Form

Rules for Objects & Object Form

- If the noun ends in a consonant:
 - If it ends in a glottal stop ('), then we add *-ti'* /kwichii' → kwichii'ti'
 - If it ends in any other consonant then we just add *-i'* /huunat → huunati'
- **Note:** Sometimes if the noun ends in **c**, then in the object form it might change to *-chi'*. [kihuuc → kihuuchi']

Verb: hihii (to see)

Singular	Plural
Hihii n – I see	Hihi ich – We see
Hihii m – You see	Hihi imch – You guys see
Hihii – He/She/It sees	Hihi im – They see

Example Sentences

- **I** see the wildcat.
 - Hihii**n** tukuti'.
- **We** see the horse.
 - Hihi**ich** wa'urravi'ti'.
- **They** see the gray dog.
 - Hihii**m** kwichii'ti' piver'chka'ti'.
- He sees the red bird.
 - Hihii wichiiti' shurriinka'ti'.
